Enrollment Projections ...

- Data from 2018 to 2024 reveals a 15.9% decrease in the total student population
- Projections for 2026-27 estimate a total enrollment of 1,273 students
- Projected enrollment by 2033 based on birth data trends, is anticipated between 879-937 (~912 students UPK-12) students

Fiscal Sustainability



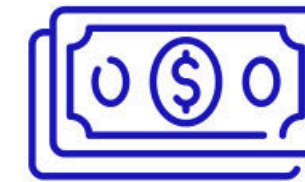
Budget Deficit

The 2026-2027 budget has a projected deficit of \$2.54 million



Foundation Aid

Foundation Aid is projected to increase by only 1%, or \$220,000



Tax Levy

Without restructuring, current programming will substantiate an increase of 20%

➤ Collaboration

➤ Environment

A dedicated primary school with a nurturing environment that establishes grade level cohorts in support of strong peer relationships with which to transition to future grade levels

An intermediate school with specialized spaces that reflect curriculum and student learning needs

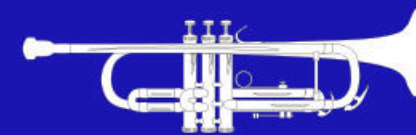
